COURSE AND ACTIVITIES

All school social activities are supervised by school staff who can assist the students attending the activity. We strongly advise all students to return to their accommodation with a friend, or by taxi, particularly in the evening.
- Our son/daughter will have sufficient money to pay for meals and for transportation in London.
